## COMPOSITION, SCOPE AND PROCEDURE OF AREA 93 TREATEMENT FACILITIES COMMITTEE

The **C.C.A.A.** Treatment Facilities Committee (TFC) provides information to treatment facilities staff and clients as to what AA is and is not. The TFC coordinates with California Hospitals and Institutions (H&I) for facilities covered. Area 93 TFC does not go to lockdown facilities. The committee maintains a list of treatment facilities in Area 93 by zip code. TFC also maintains a list of active members who are willing to help clients of treatment facilities to experience AA in their home community thru the Bridging The Gap (BTG) program. TFC also coordinates phone numbers for clients of treatment facilities to contact BTG for assistance to experience AA in their home community. On occasion the TFC may, with coordination with a facility, have AA meetings at a facility keeping in mind our tradition of non-affiliation.

MEMBERSHIP: Any interested AA member is eligible to be an area Treatment Facilities committee member.

BUDGET: The annual budget for each committee shall be handed to the Committee Chairperson by the Area Treasurer. Any funds required over budget may be requested by the Chair that committee or an appointed member of the committee, by first visiting the Finance Committee meeting at an Area Assembly. The Finance Committee shall advise the member whether or not the funds are available. If the funds are available, the member shall ask the Area Chair to add the request to the agenda for consideration by the Area Assembly. If the Area Chair adds the item/s to the agenda, the assembly shall vote on the request for the additional funds. If the Area Chair does not add the items to the Area Assembly, the member may request that the item be added to the next scheduled Area Assembly
